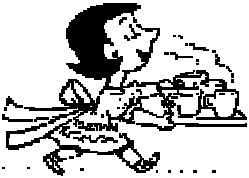




**Visitation:**

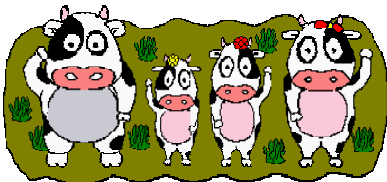
