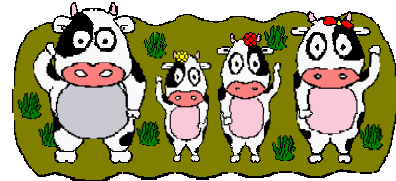

### OUR COWTOWN CALLERS FOR NOVEMBER



**FRANCOIS LAMOUREUX** (from Nevada) – Friday, November 6: Francois Lamoureux learned square dancing in Munich, Germany, graduating in 1986. He began calling in 1988. He was calling and teaching for several clubs in the Munich area, including the Munich Dip ‘n Divers, one of Germany’s oldest and largest

clubs. Soon he was also guest calling for an average of about ten to fifteen clubs a year. He called on numerous European Jamborees and Special Dances, as well as many National Square Dance Conventions in the United States. He recorded on the “Snow” label. He became an active member of ECTA (European Callers and Teachers Association) and CALLERLAB. Especially in CALLERLAB he has been active in several committees.

He quit serving as vice chairman of the Overseas Advisory Committee in 2007. In 2007 he and Regina, his wife of fifteen years, moved from Munich to Henderson, Nevada.



**BUDDY WEAVER** – Friday, November 20: Buddy began calling in his native state of Hawaii in 1977. He is a third generation Square Dance pioneer, starting the first Advanced program in Hawaii and the first Multi-Cycle New Dancer programs in Hawaii and

San Diego. Buddy has been featured in Australia, Canada, Denmark, Germany, Japan, New Zealand, Sweden and twenty four United States. He is the first American Square Dance Caller to perform in Poland.

Since 1981, Buddy has recorded over 60 Square Dance records and is the owner/producer of **BLUE STAR RECORD PRODUCTIONS.**

Buddy and his family reside in San Diego, California where he hosts weekly beginner, Plus, & Advanced programs, and has been sponsor of Square Dance promotions at the 2nd largest Street Fair in California.

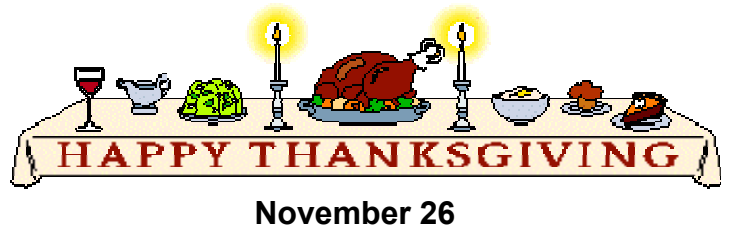
