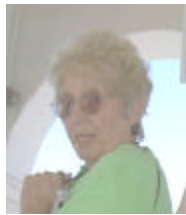
**Social Activities:**

## OUR COWTOWN CALLERS FOR NOVEMBER:



VIC KAARIA – Friday, November 3: Vic began calling in 1975. He enjoys the geometric patterns as well as the possibilities and arrangements associated with Square Dancing. He especially enjoys the opportunity to actually sing. Vic learned to call in a class sponsored by full-time caller, Larry Jack. After the class, he began calling for teen and adult groups.

After calling for about three years, Vic met another full-time caller, Skip Stanley. After countless hours spent with Skip, assisting him to “fine tune” his skills and understanding the activity, a lifelong friendship developed.

Vic has called all levels from Basic through Challenge Level 1. Currently, he calls only Basic through A2.

Vic has recorded several singing calls on various Square Dance labels: Winsor, Fine Tune Records, Pro-To-Call, Gold Wing Records and Shakedown Records.

He has three children with his wife, Shauna, as well as three stepchildren.

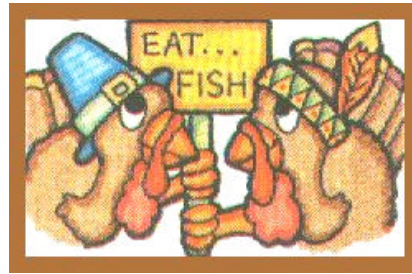


BUDDY WEAVER – Friday, November 17: Buddy began calling in his native state of Hawaii in 1977. He is a third generation Square Dance pioneer, starting the first Advanced program in Hawaii and the first Multi-Cycle New Dancer

programs in Hawaii and San Diego. Buddy has been featured in Australia, Canada, Denmark, Germany, Japan, New Zealand, Sweden and twenty four United States. He is the first American Square Dance Caller to perform in Poland.

Since 1981, Buddy has recorded over 60 Square Dance records and is the owner/producer of BLUE STAR RECORD PRODUCTIONS.

Buddy and his family reside in San Diego, California where he hosts weekly Beginner, Plus, & Advanced programs; dance weekends in Solvang and Hemet, California; and has been sponsor of Square Dance promotions at the 2nd largest Street Fair in California.

### **This Month in History- November**

**November 1** - All Hallows Day, also known as All Saints Day among Roman Catholics, commemorating those who have no special feast day.

**November 4, 1842** - Abraham Lincoln married Mary Todd in Springfield, Illinois

**November 10, 1775** - The U.S. Marine Corps was established.

**November 11, 1938** - Irving Berlin's *God Bless America* was first performed. He had written the song especially for radio entertainer Kate Smith who sang it during her regular radio broadcast. It soon became a patriotic favorite of Americans and was one of Smith's most requested songs.

**November 14, 1666** - The first experimental blood transfusion took place in England, utilizing two dogs.

**November 26, 1789** - The first American holiday occurred, proclaimed by President George Washington to be Thanksgiving Day, a day of prayer and public thanksgiving in gratitude for the successful establishment of the new American democracy.
