What a great turn out of our club at the Breast Cancer dance. Thanks to all of you who brought finger food. It was really needed.

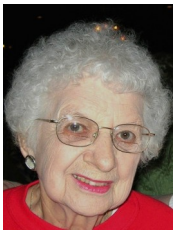

Recipe of the month from Diane Manning

French Fried Pickles

Salad Oil

1 egg, lightly beaten

3 Tbsp. Milk

1 Tbsp. Pickle Liquid (dill or sweet)

1/3 cup Pancake Mix

1 cup Pickle slices, well drained (dill or sweet cucumber)

Heat one inch of salad oil in skillet or electric skillet to 360 degrees F on deep-fat thermometer. Place egg in small mixing bowl, stir in milk and pickle liquid. Add pancake mix, stir until smooth. Dip pickle slices, one at a time, into batter. Fry in oil 1 to 2 minutes until lightly browned. Remove with slotted spoon and drain on paper towels.

Makes about 2 1/2 dozen.
